Sir:

Your Committee on Education and Military Affairs, to which
was referred H.C.R. No. 75 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RELATING TO MCKINLEY HIGH SCHOOL
PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND ATHLETIC FACILITIES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to encourage the Department of
Education to consider using a design-build process for the
construction of physical education and athletic facilities at the
site of the former Kapiolani Community College for use by McKinley
High School, and to report back to the Legislature.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from McKinley High School and the Athletic Directors and Coaches
Association of Hawaii. Comments in support of the intent of this
measure were received from the Department of Education Honolulu
District Complex Area Superintendents.

Your Committee finds that the Department of Education report
should include a way to look into contributions from developers,
particularly in the Kaka'ako area, to add to the local resources
available for educational and recreational facilities.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Adding a component of the Department of Education report
to include an investigation into public-private




partnerships to raise financial support for educational and recreational facilities in the area;

- (2) Acknowledging the large amount of development going on in the area and its impact on the community; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Education and Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 75, as amended herein, and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, in the form attached hereto as H.C.R. No. 75, S.D. 1.
