Sir:

Your Committee on Education and Military Affairs, to which
was referred S.B. No. 2075 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CAMPBELL HIGH
SCHOOL,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate moneys to
Campbell High School for an electrical overhaul and an air
conditioning system.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from Campbell High School and thirty-five individuals.

Your Committee finds that the department's remaining
electrical overhaul projects is projected at \$19,000,000 over two
years, and that this measure's appropriation shall not cover the
entire amount for the two year period. Your Committee further
finds that the successful completion of these projects is badly
needed by students and department employees alike, and the
educational process is impeded by the continued delay.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Education and Military Affairs that is attached to
this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and
purpose of S.B. No. 2075 and recommends that it pass Second
Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
