to which was referred S.B. No. 2414 entitled:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate \$6,000,000, or
so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
a grant-in-aid to the County of Hawaii to construct infrastructure
for affordable housing in Kona.


Testimony in support of the measure was submitted by the
Department of Hawaiian Home Lands and the Mayor of the County of
Hawaii.

Your Committee finds that the amount appropriated by this
measure will provide funding for a connector roadway between
Kealakehe Elementary School and Kealakehe High School, thereby
improving access and alleviating traffic congestion in the Kona
region.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Housing that is
attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the
intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2414 and recommends that it pass
Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
