Your Committees on Media, Arts, Science, and Technology and
Judiciary and Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred S.B.
No. 2673 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require the Department of
Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) to ensure that public historic
and cultural properties have sufficient surrounding public lands
to serve as a buffer.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure
from the DLNR, Office of Hawaiian Affairs, the Oahu Council of the
Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs, Malama Kukuio Kane, Hawaiian
Island Productions, and one individual.

Your Committees find that creating spatial buffers around
historic and cultural sites is crucial to preserving the physical
integrity of these fragile environments. Furthermore, such
buffers would perpetuate the spiritual characteristics of the
sites.

Your Committees further find that the taking of property by
eminent domain to create a buffer zone around historic and
cultural properties constitutes a public purpose.


As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your




Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2673 and recommend that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.


