begs leave to report as follows:


The purpose of this short form measure is to amend the law
relating to housing.

Your Committee has amended this measure by replacing its
contents with language that makes plantation communities such as
Kunia Camp, Oahu, a permitted rather than nonconforming use within
the state agricultural land use district.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Housing that is
attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the
intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2774, as amended herein, and
recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto
as S.B. No. 2774, S.D. 1, and be recommitted to the Committee on
Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Housing, for further
consideration.
