Sir:

Your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Housing,  
to which was referred S.B. No. 2916 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CONTRACTORS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require Department of  
Commerce and Consumer Affairs investigators to issue cease and  
desist citations to persons conducting activities without the  
proper licenses, rather than just permit such issuance.

Testimony in support of this measure was submitted by the  
Iron Workers Stabilization Fund and the International Association  
of Bridge, Structural, Ornamental and Reinforcing Iron Workers  
(Ironworkers Local 625). Testimony in opposition to this measure  
was submitted by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs  
and the Contractors License Board.

Your Committee finds that this measure will reduce unlicensed  
construction in Hawaii by prohibiting an unlicensed contractor or  
subcontractor from continuing work without the proper licenses.  
To ensure further discussion on this measure, your Committee has  
amended this measure by changing the effective date to July 1,  
2050.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
