Sir:

Your Committee on Human Services, to which was referred  
S.C.R. No. 88 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO  
EXAMINE THE ISSUE AND DEVELOP LEGISLATION TO HALT HUMAN  
TRAFFICKING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish a task force to  
examine the issue of human trafficking and to identify ways to  
deter trafficking, support trafficked victims, and bring human  
traffickers to justice.

The Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, City and County  
of Honolulu submitted testimony in favor of this measure.

Your Committee finds that this measure will enable interested  
groups to collaboratively identify and study the issues  
surrounding human trafficking, and propose legislation that will  
deter human trafficking, bring traffickers to justice, and protect  
its victims. However, your Committee prefers House Bill No. 2051,  
H.D. 1, S.D. 1, which was recently passed out of the Senate  
Committee on Judiciary and Hawaiian Affairs, as the means for  
accomplishing these objectives.

Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical,  
nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and style.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Human Services that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 88, as amended herein, and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Hawaiian Affairs, in the form attached hereto as S.C.R. No. 88, S.D. 1.
