SB 2057 RELATING TO TIME SHARE ZONING. TSM/IGA, CPH  
Authorizes the counties to restrict time share units and time share plans in zoning districts, if they establish a time share zoning district.

IGA ONLY

SB 2531 RELATING TO FIREARMS. IGA, JHW  
Authorizes chiefs of police to issue licenses to carry a concealed firearm. Details processes for license applications, renewals, and record keeping. Strictly prohibits carrying concealed firearms under certain circumstances. Repeals HRS section 134-9.

SB 2532 RELATING TO FIREARMS. IGA, JHW  
Exempts a retired law enforcement officer from HRS sections 134-6 through 134-9.

SB 2533 RELATING TO FIREARMS. IGA, JHW  
Preempts any and all ordinances, resolutions or motions, or administrative action of any county or county agency relating to firearms.




