DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):
(Deferred from February 3, 2006)

SB 2186	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Lowers the compulsory education age from six to five years old. Makes attendance in kindergarten mandatory.	EDM, WAM
SB 2971	RELATING TO INCOME TAX DEDUCTIONS. Allows resident individual taxpayers to claim an income tax deduction from gross income of up to \$250 per taxable year for eligible school-related expenditures paid by qualifying educators. Applies to expenses incurred after December 31, 2006.	EDM, WAM
SB 3144	RELATING TO CORPORATE SPONSORSHIP FOR EDUCATION. Establishes adopt-a-school program with DOE to which corporations would make tax-deductible contributions to fund school repair and maintenance. Establishes permanent task force on corporate donations for education to advise adopt-a-school.	EDM, WAM
SB 2497	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Establishes new research-based curriculum for kindergarten through grade six to develop students' critical and creative thinking skills. Makes appropriation.	EDM, WAM
SB 2884	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Appropriates \$225,000 for training and activities for the school community councils at the department of education.	EDM, WAM
SB 3256	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SCHOOL CUSTODIAL TRAINING. Establishes funding for the school custodial training program on Oahu to enhance the repair and maintenance skills of school custodians. Makes appropriation.	EDM, WAM
SB 2793	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Appropriates funds to support the department of education's website operations.	EDM, WAM
