SB 2345	RELATING TO THE UNIFORM ENVIRONMENTAL COVENANTS ACT. Provides for "environmental covenants" for contaminated property to assure long-term compliance with requirements needed to protect the public and environment when complete removal of contaminants is not feasible, practical, or necessary.	EIA/JHW
SB 2749	RELATING TO GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS. Provides a 10-year moratorium on testing, propagating, cultivating, growing, and raising genetically engineered taro.	EIA/WLA
SB 2750	RELATING TO GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS. Provides a 10-year moratorium on field testing, propagating, cultivating, growing, and raising genetically engineered coffee.	EIA/WLA
SB 2972	RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER PROGRAM. Requires a dealer to redeem deposit beverage containers on a one-to-one basis, and defines one-to-one basis.	EIA/CPH
