SB 2290 SD1 (SSCR2532) (Proposed SD2)	RELATING TO PROTECTION FROM SECURITY BREACHES. Requires businesses that experience a security breach to notify affected people of the breach.	CPH/MAT, JHW
SB 2292 SD1 (SSCR2513) (Proposed SD2)	RELATING TO DESTRUCTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION RECORDS. Requires businesses that maintain or possess personal information of Hawaii residents to protect against unauthorized access to or use of the information after its disposal by destroying the personal information.	CPH/MAT, JHW
SB 2289 SD1 (SSCR2472) (Proposed SD2)	RELATING TO CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTING AGENCIES. Allows consumers who are victims of identity theft to place a security freeze on their credit reports which will prohibit a consumer reporting agency from releasing any information to unauthorized parties without the consumer's express consent and provide consumers more control over who has access to their credit report.	CPH/MAT, JHW


