HB 2897 HD1 (HSCR674)	RELATING TO APPELLATE JURISDICTION. Changes sunrise date of Act 202, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, relating to appellate jurisdiction, which makes numerous changes concerning appellate courts, from 7/1/06 to 7/1/2096. (HB2897 HD1)	JHW
HB 3016 HD1 (HSCR817)	RELATING TO UNSERVED ARREST WARRANTS. Provides amnesty from prosecution or license suspension or revocation for minor traffic offenses when those offenses are pending at a time when the offender is sentenced to prison. Provides that the Judicial Council shall conduct a review of the backlog of arrest warrants. (HB3016 HD1)	JHW
