HB 2265 HD2 (HSCR907-06)	RELATING TO CORRECTIONS. Transfers continuing supervisory and counseling functions of paroled individuals from Hawaii Paroling Authority to Department of Public Safety. (HB2265 HD2)	JHW
HB 2287 HD1 (SSCR3142)	RELATING TO CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT. Allows the CSEA to suspend licenses of those individuals who have become delinquent in making payment after entering into an agreement once notice was sent informing the individual of the license suspension process, rather than having to reinstate the entire license suspension process from the beginning. (HB2287 HD1)	CPH, JHW
HB 2901 (SSCR3138)	RELATING TO GARNISHMENT. Repeals the law requiring a creditor collecting money under a garnishment process to furnish duplicate receipts to the garnishee.	CPH, JHW


