DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):
(Deferred from Wednesday, March 15, 2006)

HB 487 HD1, SD1 (SSCR1140) (PROPOSED SD2)	RELATING TO TAXATION. Exempts from GET and use taxes the fuel used in interstate and intrastate air transportation by common carriers. (SD2)	TGO, WAM
HB 2746 HD3 (HSCR924)	RELATING TO AVIATION FUEL TAXES. Exempts aviation fuel from excise, use, and fuel taxes under certain circumstances. (HB2746 HD3)	TGO, WAM
HB 2075 HD1 (HSCR731)	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Earmarks a percentage of federally allocated moneys from the state highway fund for bikeways. (HB2075 HD1)	TGO, WAM
HB 3087 HD2 (HSCR867)	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Gives the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC) more autonomy regarding procurement matters by designating the chief executive officer of HHSC as the chief procurement officer. Raises the amount for which a purchase may qualify as a small purchase from \$25,000 to \$50,000. (HB3087 HD2)	TGO/HTH, WAM
HB 3123 HD1 (HSCR694)	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS. Funds a study to assess the structural integrity of each hospital and nursing home facility to determine their ability to withstand hurricanes. Makes appropriation. (HB3123 HD1)	TGO/HTH, WAM
