# A BILL FOR AN ACT VETO OVERRIDE

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately 2
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- "§150A-A Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service 4
- fee and charge. (a) There is imposed a fee for the inspection, 5
- quarantine, and eradication of invasive species contained in any 6
- marine commercial container shipment, foreign or domestic, that 7
- is brought into the State. The fee shall be computed on the
- basis of \$1 for each twenty-foot equivalent unit per container. 9
- The department shall collect the fee at the port of 10
- disembarkation and deposit the fee into the pest control, 11
- 12 quarantine, and eradication fund under section 150A-B.
- §150A-B Pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund. 13
- (a) There is established in the state treasury the pest 14
- 15 inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund, into which shall
- 16 be deposited:

16	course of inspection and quarantine activities by the	
17	department."

19	1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute	
20	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating	
21	the new sections in this Act.
