RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 286-102.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 3 If the provisional licensee violates any of the requirements of subsection (b) or (c): 4 5 For a first violation of any requirement, the (1)6 provisional license shall be suspended for a period of 7 three months by a district court or family court judge. If the person's provisional license is 9 suspended, the person shall not be eligible for reissuance of the provisional license or issuance of a 10 11 driver's license until: 12 The person is eighteen years of age; or (A) 13 Three months have elapsed since the date of (B) 14 suspension, 15 whichever is sooner, and the person has otherwise 16 satisfied the requirements of this chapter; and
