A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII MACADAMIA NUT PRODUCT LABELING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	1.	Section	486-120.5,	Hawaii	Revised	Statutes,	is
2	amended as f	ollo	ws:					

3	"§486-120.5 Macadamia nuts; labeling requirements. (a)
4	If a label on a consumer package contains language that all of
5	the raw or processed macadamia nuts contained in the package
6	were grown in Hawaii, the label shall be worded, "100% Hawaii-
7	Grown Macadamia Nuts", "Hawaii-Grown Macadamia Nuts", "100%
8	Hawaiian Macadamia Nuts", or "Hawaiian Macadamia Nuts", and

shall appear on the principal display panel of the package.

10	(b) If a label on a consumer package contains language
11	that a portion of the raw or processed macadamia nuts contained
12	in the package was grown in Hawaii, the label shall be worded
13	"Hawaii-Grown Macadamia Nuts", preceded by the per cent by
14	weight of the macadamia nuts contained in the package that were
15	grown in Hawaii, and shall appear on the principal display panel
16	of the package. The per cent by weight of the macadamia nuts in
17	the package shall be the percentage calculated by dividing the
12	weight in pounds of the macadamia nuts grown in Hawaii that are



1	in the package by the weight in pounds of all macadamia nuts in				
2	the package and multiplying the quotient by one hundred.				
3	[(b)] <u>(c)</u> All nonconsumer packages containing macadamia				
4	nuts grown in the State and introduced into intrastate or				
5	interstate $commerce[\tau]$ shall bear on the package a label				
6	containing language that the package contains Hawaii-grown				
7	macadamia nuts. This label shall be in addition to all other				
8	labeling requirements specified in this chapter.				
9	[(c)] (d) Any person keeping, offering, displaying,				
10	exposing for sale, or soliciting for sale, any raw or processed				
11	macadamia nut product, which represents or which is branded or				
12	labeled that all or a percentage or portion of the macadamia				
13	nuts were grown in Hawaii, shall make available to the				
14	administrator, upon demand, documented proof that [one hundred				
15	per cent of] the amount of macadamia nuts [were] represented to				
16	be grown in the State, was grown in the State.				
17	$[\frac{(d)}{(e)}]$ It shall be a violation of this part $[\frac{te}{2}]$:				
18	(1) To use a label containing the words, "100% Hawaii-				
19	Grown Macadamia Nuts", "Hawaii-Grown Macadamia Nuts",				
20	"100% Hawaiian Macadamia Nuts", or "Hawaiian Macadamia				
21	Nuts", or similar wording, or to otherwise represent				
22	that all of the macadamia nuts in the package were				

1		grown in Hawaii, if any portion of the macadamia nuts		
2		contained in the package [are] was not grown in the		
3		State[+];		
4	(2)	To use a label, as provided for under subsection (b),		
5		containing the words "Hawaii-Grown Macadamia Nuts"		
6		preceded by a percentage, if less than the specified		
7		percentage or none of the macadamia nuts in the		
8		package was grown in the State; or		
9	(3)	To use a label representing that any of the macadamia		
10		nuts contained in the package was grown in the State,		
11		if none of the macadamia nuts contained in the package		
12		was grown in the State.		
13	(f)	Any person who violates this section shall be subject		
14	to penalt:	ies under section 486-32."		
15	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
16	matured, p	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
17	begun, bet	fore its effective date.		
18	SECT	ION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.			
20	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
