## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRANTS-IN-AID.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 42F-103, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] \$42F-103[+] Standards for the award of grants and
- 4 subsidies. (a) Grants and subsidies shall [only] be awarded
- 5 only to individuals who, and organizations [which:] that:
- 6 (1) Are licensed or accredited, in accordance with
  7 federal, state, or county statutes, rules, or
  8 ordinances, to conduct the activities or provide the
  - (2) Comply with all applicable federal and state laws prohibiting discrimination against any person on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or disability;

services for which a grant or subsidy is awarded;

- (3) Agree not to use state funds for entertainment or lobbying activities; and
  - (4) Allow the state agency to which funds for the grant or subsidy were appropriated for expenditure, legislative committees and their staff, and the auditor full

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1		access to their records, reports, rives, and other
2		related documents and information for purposes of
3		monitoring, measuring the effectiveness, and
4		[assuring] ensuring the proper expenditure of the
5		grant or subsidy.
6	(b)	In addition, a grant or subsidy may be made to an
7	organizat	ion only if the organization:
8	(1)	Is incorporated under the laws of the State; and
9	(2)	Has bylaws or policies that describe the manner in
10		which the activities or services for which a grant or
11		subsidy is awarded shall be conducted or provided.
12	(c)	Further, a grant or subsidy may be awarded to a non-
13	profit or	ganization only if the organization:
14	(1)	Has been determined and designated to be a non-profit
15		organization by the Internal Revenue Service; and
16	(2)	Has a governing board whose members have no material
17		conflict of interest and serve without compensation.
18	(d)	If a grant or subsidy is used by an organization for
19	the acqui	sition of land, when the organization discontinues the
20	activitie	s or services on the land acquired for which the grant
21	or subsid	y was awarded and disposes of the land in fee simple or
22	by lease,	the organization shall negotiate with the expending

- 1 agency for a lump sum or installment repayment to the State of
- 2 the amount of the grant or subsidy used for the acquisition of
- 3 the land. This restriction shall be registered, recorded, and
- 4 indexed in the bureau of conveyances or with the assistant
- registrar of the land court as an encumbrance on the property. 5
- 6 Amounts received from the repayment of a grant or subsidy under
- 7 this subsection shall be deposited into the general fund."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and
- stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 9

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
