## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTING AGENCIES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 489P-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: [A] Any consumer who [has been the victim of identity 3 theft] is a resident of this state may place a security freeze 4 on the consumer's credit report [by making a request in writing 5 by certified mail to a consumer credit reporting agency, at an 6 address designated by the agency to receive such requests, with 7 a valid copy of a police report, investigative report, or 8 complaint the consumer has filed with a law enforcement agency 9 10 about unlawful use of the consumer's personal information by another person]. A consumer credit reporting agency shall not 11 charge a victim of identity theft a fee for placing, lifting, or 12 13 removing a security freeze on a credit report [-] but may charge any other consumer a fee not to exceed \$5 for each request by 14 the consumer to place, lift, or remove a security freeze from 15 16 the consumer's credit report.
- A consumer who is a resident of this state and has been the
- 18 victim of identity theft may place a security freeze on the



- 1 consumer's credit report by making a request in writing by
- 2 certified mail to a consumer credit reporting agency, at an
- 3 address designated by the agency to receive such requests, with
- 4 a valid copy of a police report, investigative report, or
- 5 complaint the consumer has filed with a law enforcement agency
- 6 about unlawful use of the consumer's personal information by
- 7 another person. A consumer who has not been the victim of
- 8 identity theft may place a security freeze on the consumer's
- 9 credit report by making a request in writing by certified mail
- to a consumer credit reporting agency.
- 11 A security freeze shall prohibit the consumer credit
- 12 reporting agency from releasing the consumer's credit report or
- 13 any information from it without the express authorization of the
- 14 consumer. This subsection shall not prevent a consumer credit
- 15 reporting agency from advising a third party that a security
- 16 freeze is in effect with respect to the consumer's credit
- 17 report."
- 18 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
