A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there are three
- 2 pending class action lawsuits against the department of
- 3 education entitled Garner v. Department of Education, Kliternick
- 4 v. Hamamoto, and Kawashima v. Department of Education, which
- 5 involve disputes between the department of education and
- 6 substitute and part-time teachers over allegations of unpaid
- 7 wages since 1996.
- 8 These lawsuits have created a significant strain between
- 9 the affected teachers and the department of education, resulting
- 10 in declining teacher morale, distrust, and attrition of needed
- 11 employees. The legislature further finds that these cases
- 12 require expeditious action to resolve a major public issue
- 13 adversely impacting Hawaii's public education system. There are
- 14 over 10,000 substitute and part-time teachers who proudly serve
- 15 the department of education. Without substitute and part-time
- 16 teachers, Hawaii's public education system could not function.

Providing a settlement between the substitute and part-time 1 2 teachers and the department of education will restore goodwill and harmony between these teachers and the department of 3 education to ultimately better serve Hawaii's public school 4 5 students. 6 SECTION 2. The funds appropriated by this measure are intended to settle the above-referenced lawsuits between part-7 time and substitute teachers and the department of education, 8 and are separate and apart from the funds appropriated to the 9 10 department of education for operational and educational 11 purposes. SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and 14 15 the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for retroactive salary adjustments for 16 public school part-time and substitute teachers beginning from **17** 18 July 1, 1996, which amounts shall be paid to part-time and substitute teachers if such payments will settle the pending 19 class action lawsuits. 20 21 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 22 of education for purposes of this Act; provided that it shall

- 1 not adversely affect the moneys otherwise made available to the
- 2 department of education for operational and educational
- 3 purposes.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
