A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Mililani's thirty-seventh representative
- 2 district encompasses the new and expanding area of Mililani
- 3 Mauka and the oldest part of the town, including the town
- 4 center. The original Mililani schools are nearly forty years
- 5 old. These schools have many issues, including repair and
- 6 maintenance, as well as facilities that are outdated and in need
- 7 of restoration. Traffic congestion and safety is a problem at
- 8 all the schools, and to avoid further problems, a solution is
- 9 proposed for the ten-classroom building being constructed at
- 10 Mililani High School.
- 11 The Mililani Mauka area experiences heavy rainfall and
- 12 there is a need to provide covered play courts and covered bus
- 13 stops to address a concern for the health and safety of the
- 14 students.
