A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOBACCO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 709-908, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: Tobacco; minors. (1) It shall be unlawful to 3 "§709-908 4 sell or furnish tobacco in any shape or form, including chewing tobacco and snuff, to a minor [under eighteen years of age]. 5 Signs using the statement, "The sale of tobacco (2) products to persons under eighteen is prohibited", shall be 7 posted on or near any vending machine in letters at least one-8 half inch high and at or near the point of sale of any other 9 10 location where tobacco products are sold in letters at least one-half inch high. 11 12 (3) It shall be unlawful for a minor [under eighteen years of age] to purchase, possess, or use any tobacco product, as 13 14 described under subsection (1). This [provision does] section 15 shall not apply [if a person under the age of eighteen,] to: 16 Any minor, with parental authorization, who is (a) participating in a controlled purchase as part of a 17 law enforcement activity or a study authorized by the 18

Description:

Makes it unlawful for minors (persons under age 18) to possess or use tobacco products. Exempts minors when lawfully delivering tobacco products or participating in a law enforcement activity. Subjects violator of a subsequent offense to possible, rather than mandatory, community service.
