A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary 2 in part VII of chapter 206E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Hawaii 3 community development authority, in cooperation with the city 4 and county of Honolulu, shall develop a plan for an affordable 5 housing community within the Kalaeloa community development 6 district established under section 206E-193, Hawaii Revised 7 Statutes. The development plan shall include: 8 A public-private partnership for a master-planned (1)9 community with a mixed-use design incorporating 10 compatible industrial, commercial, residential, and 11 public uses that may coexist within the same area; 12 (2) A connection to the Oahu mass transit project provided 13 for under Act 247, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, that 14 is convenient for riders; 15 (3) Ample parks and open space maintaining a rural 16 character and lifestyle; and

17 (4) Mixed-income residential dwellings, including rental
18 units and for-sale owner-occupied units, wherein at HB105 HD1 HMS 2007-1902

15		the area median income as determined by the
16		United States Department of Housing and Urban
17		Development.

18 The development plan shall preserve all of the units as 19 affordable in perpetuity by considering community land trusts 20 and other strategies. The authority shall consult with the 21 surrounding community and consider public input throughout the 22 planning process. Nothing herein shall supersede, conflict



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with, or duplicate any of the work already conducted by the
 authority in its approved reuse plan and any subsequent
 amendments thereto as authorized under section 206E-194(2),
 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for the 8 Hawaii community development authority, in cooperation with the 9 city and county of Honolulu, to develop a plan for an affordable 10 housing community within the Kalaeloa community development 11 district.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii 13 community development authority for the purposes of this Act. 14 SECTION 3. No later than twenty days prior to the 15 convening of the regular session of 2008, the Hawaii community 16 development authority shall submit to the legislature a report 17 of the authority's progress in developing a plan for an 18 affordable housing community within the Kalaeloa community 19 development district.

20 SECTION 4. No later than twenty days prior to the 21 convening of the regular session of 2009, the Hawaii community 22 development authority shall submit to the legislature a final HB105 HD1 HMS 2007-1902 HB105 HD1 HMS 2007-1902



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report of the authority's development plan for an affordable
 housing community within the Kalaeloa community development
 district, including any proposed legislation.

4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
