A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTIFICATES OF NEED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) There shall be established a twelve-member				
2	certifica	te of	need study blue ribbon panel. The members shall		
3	include the director of health and eleven members of the public.				
4	The publi	c mem	bers shall be appointed as follows:		
5	(1)	Thre	ee persons shall be appointed by the president of		
6		the	senate, of which:		
7		(A)	One shall be a licensed healthcare professional;		
8		(B)	One shall be a representative of a licensed		
9			healthcare facility; and		
10		(C)	One shall have knowledge about healthcare		
11			financing;		
12	(2)	Thre	ee persons shall be appointed by the speaker of the		
13		hous	se of representatives, of which:		
14		(A)	One shall be a licensed healthcare professional;		
15		(B)	One shall be a representative of a licensed		
16			healthcare facility; and		
17		(C)	One shall have knowledge about healthcare		
18			financing;		

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1		and		
2	(3)	Five persons shall be appointed by the governor, of		
3		which:		
4		(A) One shall be a licensed healthcare professional;		
5		(B) One shall be a representative of a licensed		
6		healthcare facility; and		
7		(C) Three shall have knowledge about healthcare		
8		financing.		
9	Vacancies	in the membership of the panel shall be filled in the		
10	same manner provided for the original appointments.			
11	(b)	The membership of the panel shall vote to elect a		
12	chairpers	mairperson.		
13	(c)	The panel shall be entitled to request assistance and		
14	information from the employees of any state, county, or			
15	municipal	department, board, bureau, commission, or agency as		
16	may be required for its purposes. The department of health			
17	shall pro	vide staff support for the panel.		
18	(d)	The panel shall conduct a comprehensive study to		
19	examine:			
20	(1)	Certificate of need processes in other states that		
21		have been modified or eliminated, and the effects of		
22		the modifications or elimination;		

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1	(2)	What other states are doing to reform the certificate
2		of need process; and
3	(3)	The impact that modification or elimination of the
4		certificate of need process may have on the state with
5		regard to:
6		(A) Access to care by residents;
7		(B) Quality of care;
8		(C) Services that are delivered statewide or on a
9		regional basis; and
10		(D) Funding, including programs such as medicaid;
11	(e)	The panel shall submit a report to the legislature no
12	later tha	n twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
13	session o	f 2008. The report shall include recommendations,
14	including	suggested legislation, if any, on:
15	(1)	The panel's findings with regard to other state's
16		experiences with the certificate of need process;
17	(2)	The future of Hawaii's certificate of need process;
18	(3)	Which healthcare services or facilities, if any,
19		should continue to be subject to the certificate of
20		need requirements or other state regulation; and
21	(4)	Which services or facilities should be exempt from
22		state regulation.

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SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
