A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY-BASED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the business 2 community, nonprofit organizations, and other entrepreneurs 3 require a functional, service-oriented agency that is readily accessible to provide business counseling, financial backing, 4 and general support to foster real community-based economic 5 development of the various products and services demonstrating 6 and embracing Hawaii's diversified economy. 7 8 The Hawaii community-based economic development technical 9 and financial assistance program of the department of business, economic development, and tourism was established for this very 10 purpose. The legislature has authorized the Hawaii community-11 12 based economic development technical and financial assistance program to provide needed financial assistance to community-13 based entrepreneurs through low-interest loans and grants to 14 15 qualifying applicants. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the 16 Hawaii community-based economic development technical and 17

1	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000, or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
4	same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5	2008-2009, to be deposited into the community-based economic
6	development revolving fund.
7	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the community-
8	based economic development revolving fund of the State of Hawaii
9	the sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for
10	fiscal year 2007-2008 and the same sum, or so much thereof as
11	may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, to provide grants
12	and low-interest loans under the Hawaii community-based economic
13	development technical and financial assistance program.
14	SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
15°	department of business, economic development, and tourism for
16	the purposes of this Act.
17	SECTION 5. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
