A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PUNA DISTRICT POLICE STATION IN KEA'AU, HAWAI'I.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The district of Puna is the third largest 2 police district in the county of Hawai'i and consists of 3 approximately four hundred ninety-nine square miles. According 4 to the 2000 census, the district accounts for approximately 5 twenty-one per cent of the island's population and attracted 6 approximately ten thousand five hundred new residents during the 7 last decade, thereby becoming the fastest growing district on 8 the island of Hawai'i. The current police station in Kea'au was 9 originally built in 1969 and expanded in 1986. At the time of 10 the last expansion, the facility housed thirty-three sworn 11 personnel and one clerical position. Since then, the police 12 station workforce has increased to fifty-three sworn personnel 13 and two civilian positions. The facility is located on land that has no additional space for improvements or expansion. 14 The current facility is cramped and only has a single 15 16 interview and waiting room for use by both victims and suspects. 17 Locker room facilities are inadequate, as there is only one

shower, one lavatory, and one sink for all male employees to
 share. The break room is the size of a walk-in pantry.
 Officers can reheat their meals and get a cup of coffee, but
 there is not enough room for a table or chairs for officers to
 use during their break.

6 A new facility is needed to house seventy sworn personnel and four civilian employees, interview rooms, holding cells, an 7 evidence room, public reception area with adequate security 8 partitions, adult offender processing rooms, and separate 9 10 facilities to process juvenile offenders. The new facility must 11 also be in compliance with the requirements of the Americans 12 With Disabilities Act. The total cost of the facility, including planning, design, and construction costs, is estimated 13 14 at \$6,500,000.

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1 or so much thereof 17 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for a grant-in-aid 18 to the county of Hawai'i for the planning, design, and 19 construction of the Puna district police station in Kea'au, 18 Hawai'i.

The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
Hawai'i for the purposes of this Act.
