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### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADULT PROBATION RECORDS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 806-73, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is						
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:						
3	"(b) All adult probation records shall be confidential and						
4	shall not be deemed [ <del>to be</del> ] public records. As used in this						
5	section, the term "records" includes, but is not limited to, all						
6	records made by any adult probation officer in the course of						
7	performing the probation officer's official duties. The						
8	records, or the content of the records, shall be divulged only						
9	as follows:						
10	(1) A copy of any adult probation case record or of a						
11	portion of it, or the case record itself, upon						
12	request, may be provided to:						
13	(A) An adult probation officer, court officer, social						
14	worker of a Hawaii state adult probation unit, or						
15	a family court officer who is preparing a report						
16	for the courts; or						
17	(B) A state or federal criminal justice agency, or						
18	state or federal court program that:						



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1		(i) Is providing supervision of a defendant or
2		offender convicted and sentenced by the
3		courts of Hawaii; or
4		(ii) Is responsible for the preparation of a
5		report for a court;
6	(2)	The residence address, work address, home telephone
7		number, or work telephone number of a current or
8		former defendant shall be provided only to:
9		(A) A law enforcement officer as defined in section
10		710-1000(13) to locate the probationer for the
11		purpose of serving a summons or bench warrant in
12		a civil, criminal, or deportation hearing, or for
13		the purpose of a criminal investigation; or
14		(B) A collection agency or licensed attorney
15		contracted by the judiciary to collect any
16		delinquent court-ordered penalties, fines,
17		restitution, sanctions, and court costs pursuant
18		to section 601-17.5[-] <u>;</u>
19	(3)	A copy of a presentence report or investigative report
20		shall be provided only to:
21		(A) The persons or entities named in section 706-604;
22		(B) The Hawaii paroling authority;

11			(i)	Is engaged in the supervision of a defendant
12				or offender convicted and sentenced in the

14			(ii)	Is engaged in the preparation of a report
15				for a court regarding a defendant or
16				offender convicted and sentenced in the
17				courts of Hawaii;
18	(4)	Acce	ss to	adult probation records by a victim, as
19		defi	ned i	n section 706-646 to enforce an order filed
20		purs	uant	to section 706-647, shall be limited to the
21		name	and	contact information of the defendant's adult
22		prob	ation	officer[-];



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1	(5)	Notwithstanding [ <del>subsection (b)(3),</del> ] paragraph (3),				
2		upon notice to the defendant, records and information				
3		relating to the defendant's risk assessment and need				
4		for treatment services or information related to the				
5		defendant's past treatment and assessments may be				
6		provided [to]:

8		service provider assigned by adult probation to				
9		service the defendant; provided that [ <del>such</del> ] <u>the</u>				
10		information shall be given only [ <del>upon the</del>				
11		acceptance or admittance of the defendant into a				
12		treatment program;] as part of the determination				
13		for admission and the disclosed information shall				
14		remain confidential;				
15		(B) [ <del>Correctional</del> ] <u>To a correctional</u> case manager,				
16		correctional unit manager, and parole officers				
17		involved with the defendant's treatment or				
18		supervision; and				
19		(C) In accordance with applicable law, to persons or				
20		entities doing research[-];				
21	(6)	Any person, agency, or entity receiving records, or				
22		contents of records, pursuant to this subsection shall				



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1		be subject to the same restrictions on disclosure of
2		the records as Hawaii state adult probation
3		offices[+]; and
4	(7)	Any person who uses the information covered by this
5		subsection for purposes inconsistent with the intent
6		of this subsection or outside of the scope of their
7		official duties shall be fined no more than \$500."
