A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	1. Chapter 36, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended	
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to		
3	read as follows:		
4	" <u>§</u> 36−	Full disclosure of entities receiving state	
5	awards. (a)	In this section, unless the context indicates	
6	otherwise:		
7	"Entity":		
8	<u>(1)</u> <u>Inc</u>	cludes, whether for profit or nonprofit:	
9	(A)	A corporation;	
10	<u>(B)</u>	An association;	
11	<u>(C)</u>	A partnership;	
12	<u>(D)</u>	A limited liability company;	
13	<u>(E)</u>	A limited liability partnership;	
14	<u>(F)</u>	A sole proprietorship;	
15	<u>(G)</u>	Any other legal business entity;	
16	<u>(H)</u>	Any other grantee or contractor that is not	
17		excluded by subparagraph (2) or (3); and	
18	<u>(I)</u>	Any state or county entity;	
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1	(2)	On and after January 1, 2010, includes any
2		subcontractor or subgrantee; and
3	(3)	Does not include:
4		(A) An individual recipient of state public
5		assistance; or
6		(B) A state employee.
7	<u>"Se</u>	earchable website" means a website that allows the public
8	to:	
9	(1)	Search state awards by any identifying element
10		required by subsection (b);
11	(2)	Ascertain through a single search the total amount of
12		funding awarded to an entity by state award that is a
13		grant, subgrant, loan, awards cooperative agreement,
14		or other form of financial assistance, by fiscal year;
15	(3)	Ascertain through a single search the total amount of
16		funding awarded to an entity by a state award that is
17		a contract, subcontract, purchase order, task order,
18		or delivery order, by fiscal year; and
19	(4)	Download data included in subparagraph (1) included in
20		the outcome from searches.
21	<u>"</u> St	ate award" means state financial assistance and
22	expendit	cures that:
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1	(1)	Are grants, subgrants, loans, awards, cooperative		
2		agreements, other forms of financial assistance,		
3		contracts, subcontracts, purchase orders, task order		
4		and delivery orders;		
5	(2)	Do not include single transactions less than \$25,000;		
6		and		
7	(3)	Before October 1, 2009, do not include credit card		
8		transactions.		
9	(b)	Not later than January 1, 2009, the department of		
10	budget and finance, in accordance with this section, shall			
11	establish	, implement, and maintain a single searchable website,		
12	accessible by the public at no cost, that includes for each			
13	state award:			
14	(1)	The name of the entity receiving the award;		
15	(2)	The amount of the award;		
16	(3)	Information on the award, including transaction type,		
17		funding agency, the North American Industry		
18		Classification System code, program source, and an		
19		award title descriptive of the purpose of each funding		
20		action;		
21	(4)	The full address of the entity receiving the award and		
22		the primary location of performance under the award;		
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1	<u>(5)</u>	A unique identifier of the entity receiving the award
2		and of the parent entity of the recipient, if the
3		entity is owned by another entity; and
4	(6)	Any other relevant information specified by the
5		department of budget and finance.
6	The	website shall include data for fiscal year 2008 and
7	each fisc	al year thereafter.
8	The	director of finance is authorized to designate one or
9	more stat	e agencies to participate in the development,
10	establish	ment, maintenance, and support of the website. In the
11	initial d	esignation, or in subsequent instructions and guidance,
12	the direc	tor may specify the scope of the responsibilities of
13	each agen	cy.
14	<u>Stat</u>	e agencies shall comply with the instructions and
15	guidance	issued by the director of finance and shall provide
16	appropria	te assistance to the director upon request, so as to
17	assist th	e director in ensuring the existence and operation of
18	the websi	te.
19	(c)	The website established under this section:
20	(1)	Shall provide an opportunity for the public to provide
21		input about the utility of the site and
22		recommendations for improvements;

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1	(2)	hall be updated not later than thirty days after the
2		ward of any state award requiring a posting; and
3	(3)	hall provide for separate searches for the state
4		wards.
5	(d)	ot later than July 1, 2008, the director of finance
6	shall est	lish and implement a pilot program to:
7	(1)	est the collection and accession of data about
8		ubgrants and subcontracts; and
9	(2)	etermine how to implement a subaward reporting
10		rogram across the State, including:
11		A) A reporting system under which the entity issuing
12		a subgrant or subcontract is responsible for
13		fulfilling the subaward reporting requirement;
14		<u>and</u>
15		B) A mechanism for collecting and incorporating
16		agency and public feedback on the design and
17		utility of the website.
18	<u>The</u>	lot program shall terminate not later than January 1,
19	2010.	
20	Base	on the pilot program, not later than January 1, 2010,
21	the direc	r of finance:



1	(1)	Shal	l ensure that data regarding subawards are
2		disc	losed in the same manner as data regarding other
3		stat	e awards; and
4	(2)	Shal	l ensure that the method for collecting and
5		dist	ributing data about subawards:
6		<u>(A)</u>	Minimizes burdens imposed on state award
7			recipients and subaward recipients;
8		(B)	Allows state award recipients and subaward
9			recipients to allocate reasonable costs for the
10			collection and reporting of subaward data as
11			indirect costs; and
12		<u>(C)</u>	Establishes cost-effective requirements for
13			collecting subaward data under block grants,
14			formula grants, and other types of assistance to
15			local governments.
16	For	subaw	ard recipients that receive state funds through
17	county go	vernm	ents, the director of finance may extend the
18	deadline	for e	nsuring that data regarding such subawards are
19	disclosed	in t	he same manner as data regarding other state
20	awards fo	r a p	eriod not to exceed eighteen months, if the
21	director	deter	mines that compliance would impose an undue burden
22	on the sul	bawar	d recipient.
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1	(e) Any entity that demonstrates to the director of
2	finance that the gross income, from all sources, for the entity
3	did not exceed \$300,000 in the previous tax year of that entity
4	shall be exempt from the requirement to report subawards under
5	subsection (d), until the director determines that the
6	imposition of such reporting requirements will not cause an
7	undue burden on the entity.
8	(f) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the department
9	of budget and finance from including through the website
10	established under this section access to data that is publicly
11	available in any other state database.
12	(g) The director of finance shall submit to the
13	legislature not later than twenty days prior to the convening of
14	each regular session an annual report regarding the website
15	established under this section.
16	Each report shall include:
17	(1) Data regarding the usage and public feedback on the
18	utility of the site (including recommendations for
19	<pre>improving data quality and collection);</pre>
20	(2) An assessment of the reporting burden placed on state
21	award and subaward recipients; and

- 1 (3) An explanation of any extension of the subaward
- reporting deadline, if applicable.
- 3 The director of finance shall make each report publicly
- 4 available on the website established under this section.
- 5 (h) Nothing in this section shall require the disclosure
- 6 of classified information."
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
- 10 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 11 2008-2009 for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 13 of budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
