H.B. NO. 1441

A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PLANS AND CONSTRUCTION FOR THE PUNA RECREATIONAL COMPLEX IN PAHOA, HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. A Puna recreational complex facility is 2 estimated to cost about \$8,000,000. The Puna district is the 3 fastest-growing district within the county of Hawaii, yet the 4 level of service relative to public recreational facilities has 5 not been able to keep pace with the increasing demand. Everincreasing home and land values in the state and this county 6 have transformed the Puna district into one of the last and most 7 8 attractive affordable real estate markets in the islands. The 9 majority of the residential land in the district was zoned and 10 subdivided for residential development many years ago, making 11 the levying of fair share assessments impossible and the issue 12 of concurrent public facility development the sole burden of 13 government.

14 The Puna recreational complex would include a full gym with 15 amenities and an attached community center, a soccer and a 16 football field, baseball fields, a comfort station, pavilions, 17 and ample parking for concurrent uses. The complex will be

located adjacent to the county's new Pahoa police and fire
stations currently under design.

3 The Puna recreational complex will be a tremendous asset to 4 the Puna district. Its proximity to the new public safety 5 facilities would encourage safe, healthy, public recreational 6 usage and deter miscreant behavior that often occurs at or is 7 directed against public-park facilities. The location of the new site, with ingress and egress directly onto the Keaau-Pahoa 8 9 highway, makes access to the site safe, quick, and convenient 10 for all of the district's residents. The total cost of the 11 facility, including planning, design, and construction, is 12 estimated at \$8,000,000.

13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$8,000,000 or so much 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for a 16 grant-in-aid to the county of Hawaii for the planning, design, 17 and construction of a Puna recreational complex in Pahoa, Hawaii, which shall provide, but is not limited to, facilities 18 that will allow for a variety of public athletic and 19 20 recreational activities.


21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of22 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
