## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: "PART . SOIL TEST FOR DEPLETED URANIUM. 4 5 Soil samples required. The department of health 6 shall take soil samples of soil within five hundred meters of 7 all military bases in the state at least once every three months 8 to monitor the level of depleted uranium contamination. Soil 9 samples shall be taken around the perimeter of the military 10 bases at least every meters. 11 Rulemaking. The director of health may adopt §321-12 rules pursuant to chapter 91, necessary for purposes of this 13 chapter. 14 §321-Annual report to legislature. The director shall
- submit a report summarizing its findings to the legislature and the committees on health of both houses of the legislature no
- 17 later than twenty days prior to each regular session."

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sums of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and \$
- 4 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009
- 5 for the department of health to take soil samples in accordance
- 6 with this Act.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 8 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.

## Report Title:

Depleted uranium; mandatory soil samples

## Description:

Requires the Department of Health to take soil samples within 500 meters of all military bases in Hawaii to assess for depleted uranium, at least once every 3 months, and annually report to the legislature.
