A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding three new sections to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: "\$46-A Supply of potable water. To preserve the 4 5 continuous availability of potable water to the major population areas of each county, each county shall provide emergency backup 6 7 generators, or the equivalent, to the county agency responsible for maintaining the county's water supply. 8 9 §46-B Natural disasters; building design and construction; hospitals. Each county shall incorporate into its building code 10 11 by July 1, 2008, standards to ensure that all hospitals within 12 the county are able to withstand: 13 (1) Category four hurricanes; and 14 (2) Earthquakes of a magnitude up to 8.0 on the Richter 15 scale. 16 The building standards shall apply to all new and renovated 17 hospitals, including state hospitals.

6	(1) Category four hurricanes; and

9	The building standards shall apply to all new and renovated
10	buildings that are or will be designated as hurricane shelters,
11	including state buildings."
12	SECTION 2. The department of defense shall establish a
13	statewide public emergency notification system.
14	SECTION 3. The department of defense shall establish an
15	emergency communication system that:
16	(1) Establishes common communication links for all first
17	responders on each island of the state, with inter-
18	island capability for major disasters; and
19	(2) Provides for the integration of all first responders
20	into a common response plan, including professional
21	and volunteer units.
22	SECTION 4. The department of health shall:

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1	(1)	Establish a volunteer emergency response network,
2		including a community emergency response team;
3	(2)	Provide emergency medical technician training, or its
4		equivalent, to any resident who requests it; and
5	(3)	Encourage individuals who are professional first
6		responders to become involved with professional or
7		volunteer groups that deal with emergency
8		preparedness.
9	SECT	ION 5. The department of health shall establish
10	protocols	and conduct regular mandatory inspections to ensure
11	the const	ant availability of electricity and potable water in
12	hospitals	• •
13	SECT	ION 6. The department of defense, in cooperation with
14	the civil	defense agency of each county, shall provide training
15	for membe	rs of community emergency response teams, including:
16	(1)	Providing first-aid supplies and equipment for each
17		trained volunteer; and
18	(2)	Providing emergency tents, toilets, and storage for
19		each county within each county.
20	SECT	ION 7. There is appropriated out of the general
21	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
22	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for

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    details of the emergency backup generators, or the equivalent.
         SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
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    revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of $ or so much
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    thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the

    same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
    2008-2009 for the purposes described in sections 2, 3, and 6 of
17
    this Act.
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         The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department

    of defense for the purposes of this Act.
         SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general
21
    revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of $ or so much
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- 1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
- 2 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 3 2008-2009 for the purposes described in sections 4 and 5 of this
- 4 Act.
- 5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 6 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 10. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 8 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 9 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 10 the new sections in this Act.
- 11 SECTION 11. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 12. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
