A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A GRANT TO WEST MAUI SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Historically, the livestock industry has been a
- 2 significant contributor to the economy of the state. However,
- 3 in recent years, there has been a rapid and substantial decline
- 4 in industry numbers. Many attribute this decline to increasing
- 5 fuel costs that raise the transportation cost for imported feed,
- 6 supplies, and equipment.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for a
- 8 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the
- 9 west Maui soil and water conservation district to establish a
- 10 working group of representatives from the livestock industry and
- 11 other stakeholders to assist the industry.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for a
- 15 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the
- 16 west Maui soil and water conservation district to establish a

- 1 working group to support and maintain a sustainable livestock
- 2 industry in the State.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the west Maui
- 4 soil and water conservation district for the purposes of this
- 5 Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
