H.B. NO. 1529

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Senator Hiram L. Fong commission established by the legislature in Act 117, Session Laws of 2 3 Hawaii 2005, found that the senator's more than thirty years of 4 public service was distinguished by his ability to bridge party 5 and ethnic lines. Senator Fong championed civil rights, labor rights, and immigration reform. He contributed to the enactment 6 7 of Hawaii's little Wagner act, which provided for the unionization of agricultural workers. At the same time, the 8 9 Senator was a firm believer in the free market and the need to 10 stand on one's own feet.

11 The commission also found that Senator Fong's legislative 12 accomplishments owed greatly to the collaboration and 13 cooperation of democratic colleagues, particularly the other 14 senator from Hawaii, Oren E. Long, and senate majority leader, 15 senator Lyndon Johnson. The bill establishing the East-West 16 Center was introduced by Senator Oren E. Long, and its ultimate

success owed much to the leadership and collaboration of Senator
 Long and Senator Hiram L. Fong.

3 The commission recommended that the legislature establish
4 the Senator Hiram L. Fong scholarship at the University of
5 Hawaii.

6 Although not within the purview of the commission, the 7 commission suggested that Senator Oren E. Long also be honored 8 for his forty-one years of public service, including stints as 9 superintendent of public instruction for twelve years, then 10 secretary of the territory of Hawaii, governor of Hawaii, and 11 finally United States senator.

The purpose of this Act is to establish two scholarship programs, for Senator Hiram L. Fong and Senator Oren E. Long respectively, to be administered by the University of Hawaii through endowments deposited with the University of Hawaii Foundation.

SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
designated and to read as follows:

20 "<u>\$304A-</u> The Senator Hiram L. Fong scholarship program

10	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000, or so much		
12	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to be		
13	deposited with the University of Hawaii Foundation as an		
14	endowment for the Senator Hiram L. Fong scholarship; provided		
15	that the University of Hawaii shall administer the scholarship		
16	in accordance with the report of November 17, 2005 to the		
17	legislature from the Senator Hiram L. Fong commission.		
18	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of		
19	Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.		
20	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general		
21	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000, or so much		
22	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to be
