### H.B. NO. 1551

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 1 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: 4 "§46- Motor vehicle insurance data system. (a) Each 5 county shall establish and maintain a data system to identify motorists who are currently insured. The data system shall: 6 7 (1) Allow insurers to electronically transmit insurance 8 information to the counties; (2) 9 Be accessible to the police department, department of 10 motor vehicles, and department of the prosecuting attorney of any county to the extent necessary to 11 12 allow each agency to implement and enforce motor 13 vehicle insurance and related laws under the 14 jurisdiction of the respective agency; (3) Protect the privacy interests of persons whose 15 16 information is included in the data system; and Include the following information: 17 (4)



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1	<u>(A)</u>	Name, make, and model of the insured motor	
2		vehicle;	
3	<u>(B)</u>	Vehicle identification number as defined under	
4		section 286-2;	
5	(C)	Vehicle license plate number;	
6	(D)	Name of the primary insured;	
7	<u>(E)</u>	Name of the insurer;	
8	<u>(F)</u>	Effective dates of coverage; and	
9	<u>(G)</u>	Insurance policy number.	
10	(b) Each	county shall establish procedures for the	
11	transmission of insurance information by insurers required under		
12	section 431:10C The counties shall coordinate and		
13	standardize under a single schedule, the monthly transmission of		
14	information re	quired under subsection (a)."	
15	SECTION 2	. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
16	amended by add	ing a new section to article 10C to be	
17	appropriately	designated and to read as follows:	
18	" <u>§</u> 431:10C	- Motor vehicle insurance data system; county	
19	information re	quirements. (a) Every motor vehicle insurer	
20	shall provide each county with the information listed under		
21	section 46- (a) and shall notify each county of the		
22	cancellation o	f a motor vehicle insurance policy; provided that	
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1	this information shall only be provided to a county for those		
2	motor vehicles registered by the county. The information shall		
3	be transmitted on a monthly basis according to a schedule set by		
4	the counties. Every insurer shall take all necessary		
5	precautions to protect the privacy interests of persons whose		
6	information is transmitted to each county.		
7	(b) No motor vehicle insurer shall be subject to civil		
8	liability for errors or omissions in recording, maintaining, or		
9	reporting of information required under this section, except for		
10	damages that result from the motor vehicle insurer's gross		
11	negligence or wanton acts or omissions."		
12	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
14	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for the		
15	purposes of establishing and maintaining a data system to		
16	identify insured motorists, to be allocated as follows:		
17	\$ to the city and county of Honolulu;		
18	\$ to the county of Maui;		
19	\$ to the county of Hawaii; and		
20	\$ to the county of Kauai.		
21	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the counties for		
22	the purposes of this Act.		



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
