## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FAMILY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the success of a 2 society depends largely upon the vitality of its families.
- 3 Family is especially important in Hawaii because of the diverse
- 4 ethnic and cultural backgrounds of its people. House Concurrent
- 5 Resolution No. 269, regular session of 2006, requested the
- 6 governor to designate and celebrate 2008 as the year of the
- 7 family and to establish a family celebration commission to
- 8 administer the celebration. This commission is responsible for
- 9 developing, planning, and coordinating various programs and
- 10 activities throughout 2008 in celebration of the family.
- 11 The legislature further finds that a celebration is
- 12 appropriate to honor the importance of family and to sustain and
- 13 nurture family life.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 15 operating costs of the family celebration commission.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

1	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
2	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
3	2008-2009 for the operating costs of the family celebration
4	commission.
5	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the governor for
6	the purposes of this Act.
7	SECTION 3. The family celebration commission shall submit:
8	(1) An interim report, including a summary of the
9	programs and activities scheduled throughout 2008, to
10	the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
11	convening of the 2008 regular session; and
12	(2) A final report to the legislature no later than twenty

days prior to the convening of the 2009 regular
