## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER POLLUTION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 342D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended as follows:
3	1. By adding two new definitions to be appropriately
4	inserted and to read:
5	""Anchialine ponds" means bodies of water that are land-
6	locked pools, having measurable salinity, with no surface
7	connection to the sea, yet showing tidal fluctuations indicating
8	an indirect connection to the ocean.
9	"Nonfederal wetlands" means areas, as designated on maps
10	prepared by the department, that are inundated or saturated by
11	surface or ground water at a frequency and duration sufficient
12	to support, and that under normal circumstances do support, a
13	prevalence of vegetation typically adapted for life in saturated
14	soil conditions that:
15	(1) Generally include swamps, marshes, bogs, and similar
16	areas; and
17	(2) Are areas that are not subject to regulation by the
18	United States Army Corp of Engineers."

- 2. By amending the definition of "state waters" to read as
  follows:
- 3 ""State waters" means all waters, fresh, brackish, or salt,
- 4 around and within the State, including, but not limited to,
- 5 coastal waters, anchialine ponds, streams, rivers, drainage
- 6 ditches, ponds, reservoirs, canals, ground waters, nonfederal
- 7 wetlands, and lakes; provided that drainage ditches, ponds, and
- 8 reservoirs required as a part of a water pollution control
- 9 system are excluded."
- 10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
