A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMINENT DOMAIN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

5	types of prope	(a) A plaintiff that acquires a parcel of	
6	real property	through the exercise of eminent domain under this	
7	chapter shall	compensate the defendant as follows:	
8	(1) For	land classified as agricultural under chapter 205,	
9	and	other lands in actual agricultural use:	
10	(A)	Payment to the defendant equal to per cent	
11		of the fair market value of the parcel as	
12		determined under section 101-23;	
13	<u>(B)</u>	Payment of any other damages determined under	
14		section 101-23 and any loss in the defendant's	
15		trade or business that is attributable to the	
16		exercise of eminent domain; and	
17	<u>(C)</u>	Payment of the defendant's reasonable relocation	
18		costs, if any;	



1	(2)	For	a parcel of real property occupied by the
2		defe	ndant as a primary residence:
3		(A)	Payment to the defendant equal to per cent
4			of the fair market value of the property as
5			determined under section 101-23;
6		(B)	Payment of any other damages determined under
7			section 101-23 and any loss incurred in the
8			defendant's trade or business that is
9			attributable to the exercise of eminent domain;
10			<u>and</u>
11		<u>(C)</u>	Payment of the defendant's reasonable relocation
12			costs, if any;
13		<u>and</u>	
14	(3)	For	a parcel of real property not described in
15		paragraph (1) or (2):	
16		<u>(A)</u>	Payment to the defendant equal to per cent
17			of the fair market value of the parcel as
18			determined under section 101-23;
19		(B)	Payment of any other damages determined under
20			section 101-23 and any loss incurred in the
21			defendant's trade or business that is

1		attributable to the exercise of eminent domain;	
2		and	
3	<u>(C)</u>	Payment of the defendant's reasonable relocation	
4		costs, if any.	
5	(b) This	section does not limit or restrict the right of a	
6	defendant to p	ayment of any amounts authorized by law in	
7	addition to compensation or damages for the property taken from		
8	the defendant."		
9	SECTION 2	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
10	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
11	begun, before its effective date.		
12	SECTION 3	. New statutory material is underscored.	
13	SECTION 4	. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Establishes that the just condemnation price for agricultural land shall be % of value assessed pursuant to section 101-23, HRS, plus loss to business, plus relocation costs; for primary residence, %, plus loss to business or trade, plus relocation cost; for other property, %, plus loss to business or trade, plus cost of relocation.
