A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State has
- 2 explored various ways to attract qualified individuals to teach
- 3 in Hawaii's public schools. While there have been some
- 4 successes with expanding the pool of qualified teachers, a
- 5 severe teacher shortage still exists statewide. The legislature
- 6 also finds that Hawaii's teacher shortage can be mitigated by
- 7 inviting talented, motivated, and qualified foreign
- 8 intellectuals to teach in our public schools.
- 9 The legislature further finds that the contributions of
- 10 foreign intellectuals from the international community will be
- 11 an asset to Hawaii's current and future generations by helping
- 12 students become well-equipped to meet the scientific and
- 13 technological demands of the twenty-first century and promoting
- 14 a greater awareness of the global community, thereby leading to
- 15 increased cooperation, prosperity, and peace between the United
- 16 States and other countries.
- 17 The purpose of this Act, which shall be known as the
- 18 International Educational Friendship Act of 2007, is to

- 1 appropriate funds to support the development of an international
- 2 exchange program within the college of education of the
- 3 University of Hawaii to proactively recruit, educate, and
- 4 credential foreign intellectuals to serve as teachers in the
- 5 Hawaii public school system.
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$450,000, or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
- 9 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 10 2008-2009, for the development of an international exchange
- 11 program to recruit, educate, and credential foreign
- 12 intellectuals to serve as teachers.
- 13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 14 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
