A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL LIAISON FOR THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 201-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended to read as follows:

5	There is	established, within the department of business,	
6	economic	development, and tourism, an office of international

8	(b)	The office shall:	
9	(1)	Develop policies that promote and strengthen relations	
10		with other countries in the areas of international	
11		business, economy, culture, education, and the arts;	
12	(2)	Develop policies that promote transportation between,	
13		and tourism with, other countries;	
14	(3)	Develop and promote international telecommunications	
15		and high technology exchanges;	
16	(4)	Encourage the development of international [sister-	
17		city] sister-state programs, pairing the State of	
18		Hawaii [cities] with [cities] states, provinces, and

2		economic, educational, and faith-based exchanges;
3	(5)	Develop and promote Hawaii as the economic, trade,
4		commerce, transportation, banking, and tourism hub of
5		the Pacific;
6	(6)	Develop an international affairs and peace education
7		curriculum that includes studies of international
8		affairs and peace and goodwill initiatives and takes a
9		proactive, strategic approach to the development of
10		policies that promote the prevention of national and
11		international conflict, nonviolent intervention,
12		mediation, peaceful resolution of conflict, and
13		structured mediation of conflict; and
14	(7)	Provide for exchanges of individuals between Hawaii
15		and other nations to develop international and peace-
16		based initiatives.
17	<u>(c)</u>	There is created, within the office, one full-time
18	<u>equivalen</u>	t position to serve as an international liaison for the
19	legislatu	re, whose duty shall be to act as the liaison between
20	the legis	lature and the official representatives of all visiting
21	foreign co	ountries and whose duties shall include planning and

- 1 organizing the hosting of visits of all foreign delegations to
- 2 the State on behalf of the legislature.
- 3 $\left[\frac{(c)}{(c)}\right]$ (d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary $\left[\frac{1}{c}\right]$
- 4 except as provided in subsection (c), if any of the
- 5 responsibilities or duties of the office of international
- 6 affairs under this section overlap with the responsibilities or
- 7 duties of another agency or authority under this chapter, the
- 8 office of international affairs shall have exclusive
- 9 jurisdiction and authority over those responsibilities and

- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
- 14 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 15 2008-2009 for the full-time equivalent position to serve as an
- 16 international liaison for the legislature within the office of
- 17 international affairs of the department of business, economic
- 18 development, and tourism.
- 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 20 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
- 21 of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
- 4 except that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
