4	(1)	An injury incurred by an employee by the employee's
5		wilful intention to injure [oneself] <u>the employee</u> or
6		another by actively engaging in any unprovoked non-
7		work related physical altercation other than in self
8		defense, or by the employee's intoxication $[-,]$; or
9	(2)	The exacerbation of an existing, work-related injury
10		covered under this chapter through voluntary
11		participation in any recreational or social activity
12		that is not approved by an attending physician and
13		that takes place after regular work hours, including
14		employer-sponsored sporting events, team activities,
15		parties, and picnics. The attending physician shall
16		provide guidelines to a patient regarding approved
17		activities to prevent exacerbation of a work-related
18		injury; provided that failure of the attending

1	physician to provide guidelines shall not be the sole
2	reason for denying compensation under this chapter."
3	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
