A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISASTER PREPAREDNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, in an emergency situation or during a natural disaster, emergency messages from 2 3 the State need to be broadcast in many different languages to 4 advise all members of the population in Hawaii. Currently, KNDI 5 Radio, 1270 AM, a radio station on Oahu is the preeminent 6 foreign language radio station in the State. It broadcasts 7 daily programming in many languages, including Filipino, 8 Ilocano, Spanish, Tagalog, Visayan, Tongan, Marshallese, 9 Samoan, Okinawan, Chuukese, Pohnpeian, Vietnamese, 10 and Chinese. KNDI broadcasts at five thousand megahertz and its 11 signal reaches all of the counties. The station is currently 12 situated to be a primary source of multi-language emergency 13 messages and updates because it has one of the largest audience 14 of foreign language listeners in the State. 15 The purpose of this Act is to award grants to KNDI Radio 16 for the purpose of translating and broadcasting multi-language 17 emergency messages and updates, and to purchase two generators 18 so that the station can continue to broadcast multi-language
