A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

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2	SECTION 1. Chapter 103, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
3	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
4	and to read as follows:
5	"§103-A <u>Historic places renovation special fund.</u> (a)
6	There is created a historic places renovation special fund
7	into which shall be transferred one-half of one per cent of all
8	state fund appropriations for capital improvements designated
9	for the construction cost element; provided that this transfer
10	shall apply only to capital improvement appropriations that are
11	designated for the construction or renovation of state
12	buildings. The one-half of one per cent transfer requirement
13	shall not apply to appropriations from the passenger facility
14	charge special fund established by section 261-5.5.
15	(b) The historic places renovation special fund shall be
16	used solely for the renovation of sites listed on the Hawaii
17	Pagister of Historic Places

1	(c) The one-half of one per cent amount, which is included		
2	in all capital improvement appropriations, shall be calculated		
3	at the time the appropriation bills are signed into law. The		
4	moneys shall be transferred into the historic places renovation		
5	special fund upon availability of moneys from the		
6	appropriations. Each agency receiving capital improvement		
7	appropriations shall calculate the one-half of one per cent		
8	amount and transfer the moneys into the works of art special		
9	fund.		
10	(d) The comptroller and the administrator of the state		
11	historic preservation division shall decide on the specific		
12	sites to renovate, giving first consideration to renovating		
13	sites in the area of the original appropriation.		
14	The selection of architects and renovators shall be the		
15	responsibility of the comptroller and administrator of the state		
16	historic preservation division in consultation with the affected		
17	agency or department.		
18	Expenditures from the historic places renovation special		
19	fund shall be made by the comptroller.		
20	(e) The comptroller shall:		
21	(1) Provide each agency receiving capital improvement		
22	appropriations with information regarding items

11	SECTION 2. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
12	amended to read as follows:	
13	"§103-8.5	Works of art special fund. (a) There is
14	created a works	of art special fund, into which shall be
15	transferred one	per cent of all state fund appropriations for
16	capital improvem	ents designated for the construction cost
17	element; provide	d that this transfer shall apply only to capital
18	improvement appr	opriations that are designated for the
19	construction or	renovation of state buildings. The one per cent
20	transfer require	ment shall not apply to appropriations from the
21	passenger facili	ty charge special fund established by section
22	261-5.5.	

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1	(b)	The works of art special fund shall be used solely for	
2	the following purposes:		
3	(1)	Costs related to the acquisition of works of art,	
4		including any consultant or staff services required to	
5		carry out the art in public places and relocatable	
6		works of art programs;	
7	(2)	Site modifications, display, and interpretive work	
8		necessary for the exhibition of works of art;	
9	(3)	Upkeep services, including maintenance, repair, and	
10		restoration of works of art;	
11	(4)	Storing and transporting works of art[-];	
12	(5)	Renovation of sites listed on the Hawaii Register of	
13		Historic Places.	
14	(c)	The one per cent amount, which is included in all	
15	capital i	mprovement appropriations, shall be calculated at the	
16	time the appropriation bills are signed into law. The moneys		
17	shall be transferred into the works of art special fund upon		
18	availability of moneys from the appropriations. Each agency		
19	receiving capital improvement appropriations shall calculate the		
20	one per cent amount and transfer the moneys into the works of		
21	art special fund.		

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1	(d)	The comptroller and the state foundation on culture		
2	and the a	rts or the state historic preservation division, as		
3	appropriate, shall decide on the specific art objects to acquire			
4	or renovate, giving first consideration to placing appropriate			
5	pieces of art or renovating sites at the locations of the			
6	original appropriation.			
7	The selection of, commissioning artists for, reviewing of			
8	design, execution, and placement of, and the acceptance of works			
9	of art shall be the responsibility of the comptroller and the			
10	state foundation on culture and the arts in consultation with			
11	the affected agency or department.			
12	Expenditures from the works of art special fund shall be			
13	made by the comptroller.			
14	(e)	The comptroller shall:		
15	(1)	Provide each agency receiving capital improvement		
16		appropriations with information regarding items that		
17		shall be included and excluded from the one per cent		
18		amount;		
19	(2)	Ensure that each agency calculates its one per cent		
20		amount correctly; and		
21	(3)	Ensure that each agency transfers the correct amount		

to the works of art special fund in a timely manner.

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- 1 (f) The comptroller and the executive director shall track
- 2 amounts due from each agency under the one per cent requirement
- 3 as provided in this section."
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007,
- 7 provided that when the balance of the historic places renovation
- 8 special fund created by section 1 of this Act reaches
- 9 \$25,000,000, section 2 of this Act shall be repealed and section
- 10 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is reenacted in the form in
- 11 which it read on the day before the approval of this Act.
