BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

10	[(4)]	(5) For businesses utilizing advertising prepared out
11		of the State a sign no smaller than three square feet,
12		placed at the point of sale stating: "The price of
13		the battery includes disposal of your old battery" <u>and</u>
14		"A deposit of \$50 will be charged for each new lead
15		acid battery that is not exchanged with an old lead
16		<pre>acid battery" may be substituted."</pre>
