

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DAMS AND RESERVOIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 179D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y adding three new sections to be appropriately
3	designated	d and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§17</u>	9D-A Dam and reservoir repair revolving fund. (a)
5	There is	established a dam and reservoir repair revolving fund
6	into which	h shall be deposited:
7	(1)	Appropriations by the legislature;
8	(2)	Interest and fees collected by the department under
9		this chapter; and
10	(3)	Payments made on loans from the fund.
11	(b)	Moneys in the fund shall be used by the board for the
12	following	purposes::
13	(1)	Implementing emergency measures pursuant to section
14		<u>179D-B; or</u>
15	(2)	Making dam repair loans to owners of dams or
16		reservoirs with plans and specifications for the
17		alteration, repair, or removal of dams and reservoirs
18		that have been approved by the board.

         §179D-B Emergency measures. (a) When the board
2
    determines, through investigation or inspection of a dam or
    reservoir, that there is an imminent danger to public safety and
3
    that repairs, breaching of the dam, or other actions are
4
    immediately necessary to alleviate the danger, the board shall
5
6
    direct the owner to immediately initiate the emergency measures
7
    necessary or the board may initiate the emergency measures to
8
    ensure public safety.
         (b) Emergency measures shall be made at the owner's
9
    expense. When emergency measures are initiated by the board,
10
11
    the board may use moneys from the fund, for which the owner
    shall reimburse the fund in lump sum or through installment
12
13
    payments as agreed to by the board.
14
         §179D-C Dam and reservoir repair loans. (a) The board
    may make loans from the dam and reservoir repair revolving fund
15
    to owners of dams or reservoirs with an application and plans
16
    and specifications and for the alteration, repair, or removal of
17
    dams and reservoirs as approved by the board. Loans granted by
18
    the board shall be for a term of not more than twenty years.

         (b) Loans under this section shall bear interest at the

    following rates:

1	(1)	For loans with a term of not more than five years, the
2		interest rate shall be two per cent per year;
3	(2)	For loans with a term of more than five years but less
4		than ten years, the interest rate shall be four per
5		cent per year; and
6	(3)	For loans with a term of more than ten years, the
7		interest rate shall be six per cent per year.
8	(c)	An owner securing the written approval of the board
9	for the a	lteration, repair, or removal of a dam or reservoir may
10	submit an	application to the board for a loan from the dam and
11	reservoir	repair revolving fund. The board shall make loans
12	from the	dam and reservoir repair revolving fund based upon the
13	availabil	ity of funds."
14	SECT	ION 2. Section 179D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15	amending	by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
16	and to re	ad as follows:
17	" <u>"</u> Fu	nd" means the dam and reservoir repair revolving fund."
18	SECT	ION 3. Section 179D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
19	amended t	o read as follows:
20	"[+]	§179D-6[+] General powers and duties of the board of

22	resources	shall administer the dam safety program established by

- 1 this chapter. In carrying out this chapter, the board shall
- 2 cooperate with the United States government or any of its
- 3 agencies, other state agencies, and the county governments or
- 4 any of their agencies. In the performance of its duties the
- 5 board shall:
- 6 (1) Establish by rules, adopted under chapter 91, such
- 7 policies, requirements, or standards governing the
- 8 design, construction, operation, maintenance,
- 9 enlargement, alteration, repair, removal, and
- inspection of dams, reservoirs, and appurtenant works
- 11 for the protection of life and property from
- 12 structural failure of dams and reservoirs;
- 13 (2) Conduct investigations and the collection of data,
- including technological advances made in safety
- 15 practices elsewhere, as may be needed for the proper
- 16 review and study of the various features of the
- design, construction, repair, removal, and enlargement
- of dams, reservoirs, and appurtenant works. The board
- may require submittal of reports of investigations
- 20 from all owners;
- 21 (3) Conduct investigations and require reports from all
- owners to be made from time to time, such as watershed



1		investigations and studies, as may be necessary to
2		keep abreast of developments affecting stream runoff
3		and as required to facilitate its decisions;
4	(4)	Be authorized to enter upon such private property of
5		the dam or reservoir as may be necessary in making any
6		investigation or inspection required or authorized by
7		this chapter. The entry shall not constitute a cause
8		of action in favor of the owner of the land, except
9		for damages resulting from wilful acts or negligence
10		by the board or its agents;
11	(5)	Require the owners to apply for, and obtain from the
12		board, written approval of plans and specifications
13		[on the construction] for the:
14		(A) Construction of any new dam or reservoir or the
15		enlargement of any dam or reservoir prior to
16		commencement of any work;
17		(B) Alteration, repair, or removed of dams and
18		reservoirs;
19	(6)	Require the owners to file an application and secure
20		the written approval $\underline{\prime}$ of the board before commencing
21		the repair, alteration or removal of a dam or

reservoir, including the alteration $\underline{,}$ or removal of a

1		dam so that it no longer constitutes a dam or
2		reservoir as defined in this chapter. Repairs shall
3		not be deemed to apply to routine maintenance not
4		affecting the safety of the structure;
5	(7)	Require filing fees by rules to accompany each
6		application as required under the provisions of this
7		chapter[-];
8	(8)	Make loans from the dam and reservoir repair revolving
9		fund for the alteration, repair, or removal of dams
10		and reservoirs as necessary; and
11	(9)	Make expenditures for emergency measures initiated by
12		the board from the dam and reservoir repair revolving
13		fund pursuant to section 179D-B."
14	SECT	ION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much
16	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
17	same sum,	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
18	2008-2009	, to be deposited into the dam and reservoir repair
19	revolving	fund, established pursuant to section 179D-A.
20	SECT	ION 5. There is appropriated out of the dam and
21	reservoir	repair revolving fund the sum of \$, or so much
22	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the

- 1 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 2 2008-2009, for the purposes of the dam and reservoir repair
- 3 revolving fund pursuant to chapter 179D.
- 4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 5 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 6. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 7 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 8 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 9 the new sections in this Act.
- 10 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
