A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FEES IN CRIMINAL CASES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 621-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Every witness legally required to attend a state "(a) court or grand jury in any criminal case, other than a public 4 5 officer or employee, shall be entitled to [\$20] \$55 for each day's attendance and a reasonable mileage fee to be established 6 pursuant to rules adopted by the judiciary for each mile 7 actually and necessarily traveled on the ground each way, 8 including travel to and from the nearest airport when required 9 10 to travel from another island or from outside the State. 11 In addition to witness' fees, every witness $[\tau]$ who attends a state court from outside the State shall be entitled to the 12 actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus [\$110 per twenty-13 14 four-hour day, or if] \$160 for each day's attendance. Every witness who attends from any island other than that on which the 15 court holds $session[\tau]$ shall be entitled to the actual round-16 17 trip cost of plane travel, plus \$55 [per twenty-four-hour day, 18 which] for each day's attendance. When a witness from any



- 1 island other than that on which the court holds session incurs
- 2 necessary lodging expenses, the witness shall be entitled to the
- 3 actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus \$160 for each day's
- 4 attendance. These amounts shall cover all personal expenses,
- 5 such as board and lodging. [These per diem payments shall be
- 6 computed on the basis of quarter day periods of time.] "
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
