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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a shortage of school supplies for the classroom and funds to purchase the supplies has been an ongoing problem for many years. The legislature believes that to properly address this problem, purchasing power should be provided at the classroom level: a debit card system should be implemented and teachers should be authorized to use debit cards with a predetermined spending limit for the purchase

The benefits of a debit card system include:

- (1) Streamlining the process by which teachers can purchase necessary school supplies and other related curriculum support supplies, thereby eliminating the usual time required to obtain a product and the time lag for reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses; and
- (2) Providing teachers with flexibility for their purchases and allowing them to take advantage of school discounts and sales in the community.

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The legislature further finds that there are banks willing 1 2 to assist with establishing a debit card system, at little or no cost to the schools. The system can be set up to provide up-to-3 4 date spending information. The purpose of this Act is to allow the principal of each 5 public school to establish and use a debit card system that is 6 based at the individual school for the purpose of purchasing 7 necessary school and other related curriculum support supplies. 8 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 10 and to read as follows: 11 12 "\$302A- Purchases of supplies; debit card system. 13 The principal of a public school may establish and use a debit 14 card system that is based at the individual school for the 15 purpose of purchasing necessary school and other related curriculum support supplies, as deemed appropriate by the 16 17 school's academic and financial plan. 18 The board of education shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this section." 19 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 21 , or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and 22



- 1 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 2 year 2008-2009, to establish, implement, and operate a debit
- 3 card system at individual public schools for the purpose of
- 4 purchasing necessary school and other related curriculum support
- 5 supplies.

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- 6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 7 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
