A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that mopeds and their 2 riders are not subject to the same regulation as automobiles or 3 motorcycles and their drivers. 4 The legislature finds that parking for mopeds is limited, 5 especially in urban areas, and parked mopeds often obstruct all 6 or part of pedestrian sidewalks adjacent to moped parking areas. 7 The legislature finds that mopeds are often modified illegally by removing speed governors, altering exhaust systems, 8
- 9 or repairs omitted to maintain their compliance with the law.
- 10 The legislature also finds that because of their relatively
- 11 small size, mopeds are easily stolen and used by drug dealers to
- 12 get away from police by navigating through narrow areas or
- 13 abandoned easily.
- 14 SECTION 2. The state highway safety council shall
- 15 create a moped safety task force. The task force shall be
- 16 chaired by the Director of Transportation or the Director's
- 17 designee and consist of the following members:
