SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's public

 highly qualified teachers from which public school principals
 could select.

7 "(c) The board shall adopt policies, exempt from chapters

9 (1) Develop criteria allowing more individuals with trade 10 or industry experience to teach in vocational, 11 technical, and career pathway programs, and criteria 12 for the issuance of permits allowing qualified 13 individuals to teach when recommended by the 14 superintendent.
