## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FEES FOR WINDSHIELD PLACARDS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-51.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[**]§291-51.3**] **Reimbursement to counties.** The State 4 shall reimburse the counties for the unit cost of issuing a 5 removable windshield placard or a temporary removable windshield 6 placard on behalf of the State. Beginning July 1, 2006, the 7 rate of the per unit cost reimbursement shall be \$12. All fees 8 collected by the counties for issuing removable and temporary 9 removable windshield placards shall be deposited into the 10 general fund." 11 SECTION 2. Section 291-51.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended to read as follows: 13 "§291-51.6 Issuance of temporary removable windshield 14 [**parking**] **placards.** Each county shall issue one temporary 15 removable windshield placard and a second temporary removable windshield placard to each applicant who requests and presents a 16 certificate of disability that verifies the duration of the 17

1 applicant's disability in monthly increments, which shall not 2 exceed six months, and upon payment of a fee to the issuing 3 agency. All fees collected by the counties for issuing 4 temporary removable windshield placards shall be deposited into the general fund. The temporary removable windshield placard 5 6 shall be designed, fabricated, and sold to the counties at a 7 rate negotiated by the disability and communication access 8 board." 9 SECTION 3. Section 291-52.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended to read as follows: 11 "§291-52.6 Replacement of a lost, stolen, or mutilated 12 windshield placard or identification card. A removable windshield placard, temporary removable windshield placard, or 13 14 identification card that is reported lost, stolen, or mutilated shall be replaced upon [the submittal of a]: 15 (1) Submittal to the issuing agency of: 16 17 (A) A written statement by a person with a disability 18 that the placard or identification card was 19 either lost, stolen, or mutilated [and a]; 20 A completed application for a removable (B) 21 windshield placard, temporary removable
