A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THEFT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 708-831, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	"§70	8-831 Theft in the second degree. (1) A person

12	[(c)]	(d) Of an aquacultural product or part thereof from
13		premises that is fenced or enclosed in a manner
14		designed to exclude intruders or there is prominently
15		displayed on the premises a sign or signs sufficient
16		to give notice and reading as follows: "Private
17		Property"; or

[(d)] <u>(e)</u>	Of agricultural equipment, supplies, or products,
or p	part thereof, the value of which exceeds \$100 but
does	not exceed \$20,000, or of agricultural products
that	exceed twenty-five pounds, from premises that are
fenc	ed, enclosed, or secured in a manner designed to
excl	ude intruders or there is prominently displayed or
the	premises a sign or signs sufficient to give notice
and	reading as follows: "Private [Property."]
Prop	perty". The sign or signs, containing letters not
less	than two inches in height, shall be placed along
the	boundary line of the land in a manner and in such
posi	tion as to be clearly noticeable from outside the
bour	dary line. Possession of agricultural products
with	nout ownership and movement certificates, when a
cert	ificate is required pursuant to chapter 145, is
prin	na facie evidence that the products are or have
beer	n stolen.

(2) Theft in the second degree is a class C felony. A person convicted of committing the offense of theft in the second degree under [+]subsection [+(1)+(e) and (d)+(1)+(d) or (e) shall be sentenced in accordance with chapter 706, except that for the first offense, the court may impose a minimum

- 1 sentence of a fine of at least \$1,000 or [two-fold] twofold
- 2 damages sustained by the victim, whichever is greater."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun, before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 30, 2112.
